WHO WE ARE

Founded in 1881, the American Association of University Women is a national organization with over 100,000 members and local branches throughout the country. Our mission is to promote education and equity for all women and girls, lifelong education, and positive societal change. Our local branch was founded in 1921 as the College Club in Mountain Lakes and joined the AAUW two years later.

OUR BRANCH ACTIVITIES

Monthly Branch Programs: Alternating morning and evening programs usually at the Mountain Lakes Public Library. Programs have included: Financial Management for Women, Theatre Programs, and Women in History.

Annual Outing: Each year we go to a local place of interest with a lunch at a nearby restaurant. Past trips have included the Newark Museum and other places of cultural relevance to women.

Public Policy: Reports on activities and initiatives of the national AAUW. Coffee and conversation to discuss specific women's issues.

Social Events: Fall Open House at a member's home, a Holiday Brunch, and a Spring Luncheon, both at a local country club.

Enrichment Groups:

Evening and Daytime Book and Film Groups:

Discuss member-selected books and films at a member's home or in a local restaurant.

Evening and Daytime Dining Groups:

Cook and share a meal at a member's home, eat at restaurants to explore international cuisine.

University Women's Choral:

Sing weekly at practices, at our social events, and for other groups under the direction of professionally trained members.

OUR SUPPORT FOR EDUCATION

We are particularly proud of our scholarship program. Scholarships are awarded annually to women who have completed two years of college. They must either live in or attend college in Morris County. Our scholarship committee sponsors fund raising events such as wine tastings and cooking demonstrations at local restaurants, and annual letter campaigns.

Our scholarship focus is on helping women achieve their educational and professional goals. Recent scholarships have amounted to as much as \$5,000 each to two women.

OUR NATIONAL VOICE

Empowering women is central to the national AAUW's mission. This is achieved through strategic initiatives in the areas of Education and Training, Economic Security, and Leadership.

These initiatives include:

Advocacy for national and state policies that advance equity for women and girls and legal support in individual cases of discrimination in education and the workplace.

Research on gender equity in the classroom and workplace to guide policy.

STEM education: promoting education for women in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

Title IX support and advocacy for educational opportunity and access to student services while enrolled in school.

Leadership training.
